

RGS Work Experience Term 4.

Work Experience Dates: 8 November - 16 November - Year 10, 11, 12

Note: By application only by those with local SAT opportunity and in consultation with Head of VET.

Work Experience Dates: 28 November - 5 December (School Holidays). Year 10, 11

Applications are due on or before 3.50 pm Friday 17 October

Work experience forms are now electronic and available via the student cafe and parent lounge.

Applications are to be submitted to the SSO in person or via email workexperience@rgs.qld.edu.au

All work experience must be approved and organised a minimum of 3 weeks prior to starting.

NOTE: This period covers the mandated WorkCover Insurance requirements for all schools; hence why <u>all</u> Work Experience placements <u>must be pre-approved addocumented</u> by the school.
